

## Empowering 2SLGBTQIA+ Entrepreneurs Across Manitoba

The Social Entrepreneurship Enclave (SEE) provides resources, support, and community for diverse entrepreneurs across Manitoba. We provide wraparound supports to barrier-facing (BIPOC, 2SLGBTQIA+, Youth, etc.) entrepreneurs to help them succeed while supporting their well-being as full people. In addition to providing these supports, we enrich the ecosystem by convening a community of supporters who contribute their time, expertise, and services to the entrepreneurs we serve.

SEE has 2-years of federal funding, specifically for Manitoba's 2SLGBTQIA+ entrepreneurs, in order to offer a comprehensive range of free, tailored support services including:

- **Professional Coaching:** Individual and group coaching sessions to help entrepreneurs navigate growing their business.
- **Incubator Program:** A six-month cohort-based program providing wraparound support, designed to guide entrepreneurs to excel in their business amongst a community of like minded peers.
- **Learning Workshops:** Regular workshops led by industry experts on essential topics such as legal advice, financial management, and leveraging AI in business.
- **Community Events:** Networking opportunities to connect with other entrepreneurs and build supportive relationships, both in person and in our online Slack community.
- **Resources:** Access to a SEE's business development tools including cutting edge worksheets, templates, and resource databases to help you get to the next step on your journey.
- **Coworking Space:** Entrepreneurs who are located in Winnipeg are welcomed to come work at our office in the Exchange District.
- **Travel Expenses:** for remote entrepreneurs to come into Winnipeg to take part in SEE programming.

While loan programs and existing supports are essential to the growth of SMEs and new entrepreneurial ventures across the province and especially in rural and remote communities, diverse entrepreneurs often need these tailored supports to help them navigate the additional barriers they face. SEE exists to fill that gap. By providing these resources and community, we are empowering a new generation of diverse Manitoban entrepreneurs.
